



# **GARMENT CARE MANUAL**

## **GLOVES & BOOTS**

### **GLOVES**

#### **Gloves made of textile and/or synthetic leather and textile combinations:**

Hand wash in lukewarm water using mild detergent. Do not machine wash or machine dry. We recommend the use of commonly available specialty apparel detergents like Molecule brand apparel wash, available from Helmet House and it's stocking dealers. Air dry in warm dry space out of sunlight.

#### **Gloves made of leather (any animal hide) or any combination of leather, synthetic leather and textile:**

Do not wash leather gloves, ever. Wipe off any dirt, bug strikes and grime with a damp cloth moistened warm with water and a mild detergent. Air dry in warm dry space out of sunlight. Alternatively you can use specialty leather cleaning products but, very important, do not get cleaners, soap, conditioners or anything like that on the palm of glove as they could make the glove slippery.

### **FOOTWEAR**

#### **Footwear made of textile and/or synthetic leather and textile combinations:**

Rinse off the outside of footwear with cold to warm running water avoiding getting water inside. Wipe off any remaining dirt, bug strikes and grime with a damp cloth moistened with warm water and a mild detergent. If you do get water inside wipe it out with a dry cloth. Air dry in warm dry space out of sunlight. Very important, avoid getting anything other than water on the soles of the footwear as they could possibly become dangerously slippery.

#### **Footwear made of leather (any animal hide) or any combination of leather, synthetic leather and textile:**

Wipe off any dirt, bug strikes and grime with a damp cloth moistened with warm water and a mild detergent. Air dry in warm dry space out of sunlight. Alternatively, you can use specialty leather cleaning, and leather conditioning, products following the instructions on the product container. Very important, avoid getting anything other than water on the soles of the footwear as they could possibly become dangerously slippery.
