MAGNETIC & STRAP MOUNT



MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS



Super 2.0 Tank Bags by Cortech® are all easy to mount and remove. Place the bag in a position that is comfortable for you, and doesn't interfere with the motorcycle controls.

Magnetic Mount Installation

1. Make sure that the fuel tank and bottom of bag and magnet surfaces are completely clean and free from dust, dirt, oils, debris, etc.
2. Position the bag in the center (side to side as shown), with the carrying handle facing the rider. Make sure the bag is positioned in a manner that will not obstruct the handlebars, instrument panel, or your ability to safely control the motorcycle.
3. Fold down the side flaps with the additional magnets, and make sure they are sticking securely to the fuel tank.
4. Loop the safety strap (A) around the motorcycle steering yoke, and attach connecting clip to the front ring of the tank bag. Adjust the strap so there is minimal slack.

Strap Mount Installation

1. Make sure that the fuel tank and the bottom of the bag and mounting pad are completely clean and free from dust, dirt, oil, debris, etc.
2. The bag comes connected to the mounting pad. Center the mounting pad on the gas tank. Secure the front by looping the strap (B) around the steering yoke. The strap at the bottom end (C) attaches to the frame under the seat. Make sure the straps are secure and pulled tight.
3. The correct position of the Tank Bag should be with the carrying handle facing the rider.
4. Always make sure the bag is positioned in a manner that will not obstruct the handle bars, instrument panel, or your ability to safely control the motorcycle.
5. Recheck all straps to make sure they are tight and secure.

In the event of rain, there is a handy rain cover that stretches over the entire bag to keep it and all inside items dry.

Do not exceed the maximum weight limit of 10 pounds.

IMPORTANT

- Always make sure the Tank Bag is securely fastened before riding.
- Weight must be distributed with the heaviest items on the bottom.
- When mounted, make sure the bag is centered on top of the tank.
- Make sure all attachment points are connected correctly, per these instructions, before riding.
- Do not store sharp objects inside.
- Keep credit cards and electronic devices away from the magnets.
- Clean with mild soap and water only; do not use solvents. A quick wipe with a damp cloth can keep these bags looking good for a long time.
- Make sure that the fuel tank and bottom of the bag/magnet's surface is completely clean and free from dust, dirt, oils, debris, etc.
