

CARE

- Ensure your Kriega pack is fully dry before storing.
- Store in a well-ventilated, dry and dark space.
- Store by hanging or lying flat. Do not leave folded or crushed.
- Do NOT hang packs from shoulder straps when not in use.
- Regularly clean your Kriega product (see above).
- Never leave in direct sunlight when wet or damp.
- Do not overfill your Kriega pack.
- Periodically clean and lube zips to ensure smooth operation and long life.
- If Hydration HydraPak Reservoirs are stained or damaged, replacements are available.
- A range of replacement parts are available but if you require a part that isn't available, we may have it so do send us a message info@kriega.com.

CLEANING

- Empty your pack, open any zips, and remove any detachable pockets or straps. Brush off any loose dirt or debris.
- Wash by hand in lukewarm water using a mild soap and a clean sponge. For stubborn or ingrained stains and marks use a soft brush such as a nailbrush or toothbrush. This can be done in a bathtub or large sink; it is not a problem to fully submerge the pack. DO NOT machine wash, iron, use detergents, chemicals or bleaches, as these will damage the fabrics.
- Rinse with clean warm water ensuring all traces of soap are removed.
- Dry by hanging upside down with openings and zips left undone in a well-ventilated area, preferably outdoors but always away from direct sunlight. NEVER tumble dry or force dry e.g. on a radiator or cooker. To help speed the drying process, gently wipe the inside including pockets, with a clean dry towel.
